Prairie Cascade Willow

(Salix pentaphyllum 'Prairie Cascade')

Mature Height: 30'-40'

Mature Spread: 30'-35'

Growth Rate: Fast

Fall Color: Yellow

Like all weeping willows, the Prairie Cascade has graceful, weeping branches that have a bright yellow bark. It is an upright tree when young, then assumes the traditional weeping



habit as it becomes more mature. The leaves start out a bright, glossy green for spring and summer, then turn golden yellow in the fall. It is quite hardy and is excellent for wet sites. It makes an excellent addition to any water landscape, and is quite graceful. The root system is very aggressive and the tree should not be planted close to structures or underground utilities.
